POOL FILTER INSTRUCTIONS

Included in your kit -


- 1 x Air Pump
- 1 x 2 metres Airline
- 1 x Check Valve (red)
- 1 x T Line Splitter (clear)
- 1 x Flow Control Valve (yellow)
- 2 x Sponge Filters (black)


Setting Up Your Filters

- 1. Connect your airline into the output of your air pump, leave around 15-20cm of line and cut.
- 2. Connect your check valve to the end of the cut airline and add another piece of airline to the end of the check valve. Ensure that your check valve is facing in the correct direction otherwise air will now flow through. When looking at the red part of your check valve, the pointed tip should be facing the direction that is connected to the air stones.
- 3. Connect another piece of air line 20-30cm in length (or until it reaches the tank), cut the air line and connect your *T line splitter* with the bottom part of the T facing towards the check valve.
- 4. This now gives you access to two air lines for your pools. Connect a piece of air line to each end of the *T line splitter* and run them down into your pools. Once they have reached the bottom of your pools, cut the line again and connect your **sponge filters**.
- 5. Plug your air pump into a wall outlet and it will automatically turn on. It may take a few seconds for air to flow freely into the **sponge filters**. You should notice bubbles coming from the **sponge filter** in both pools.
- 6. Sometimes the air direction can favour one **sponge filter** over the other and you may end up with flow issues. If this is the case, use your flow control valve.

7. Decide which pool is getting more air and cut the line halfway between the **sponge filter** and the *T line splitter*, connect both ends of cut airline into your flow control valve and use the small dial on the end of the air flow valve to lighten the air flow. This will force air back into the other **sponge filter** and will help to control an even balance of air between both pools.

Clean your pools out and replace with fresh, Primed water every 1-2 months when using filters. Ensure you clean the sponge regularly.
